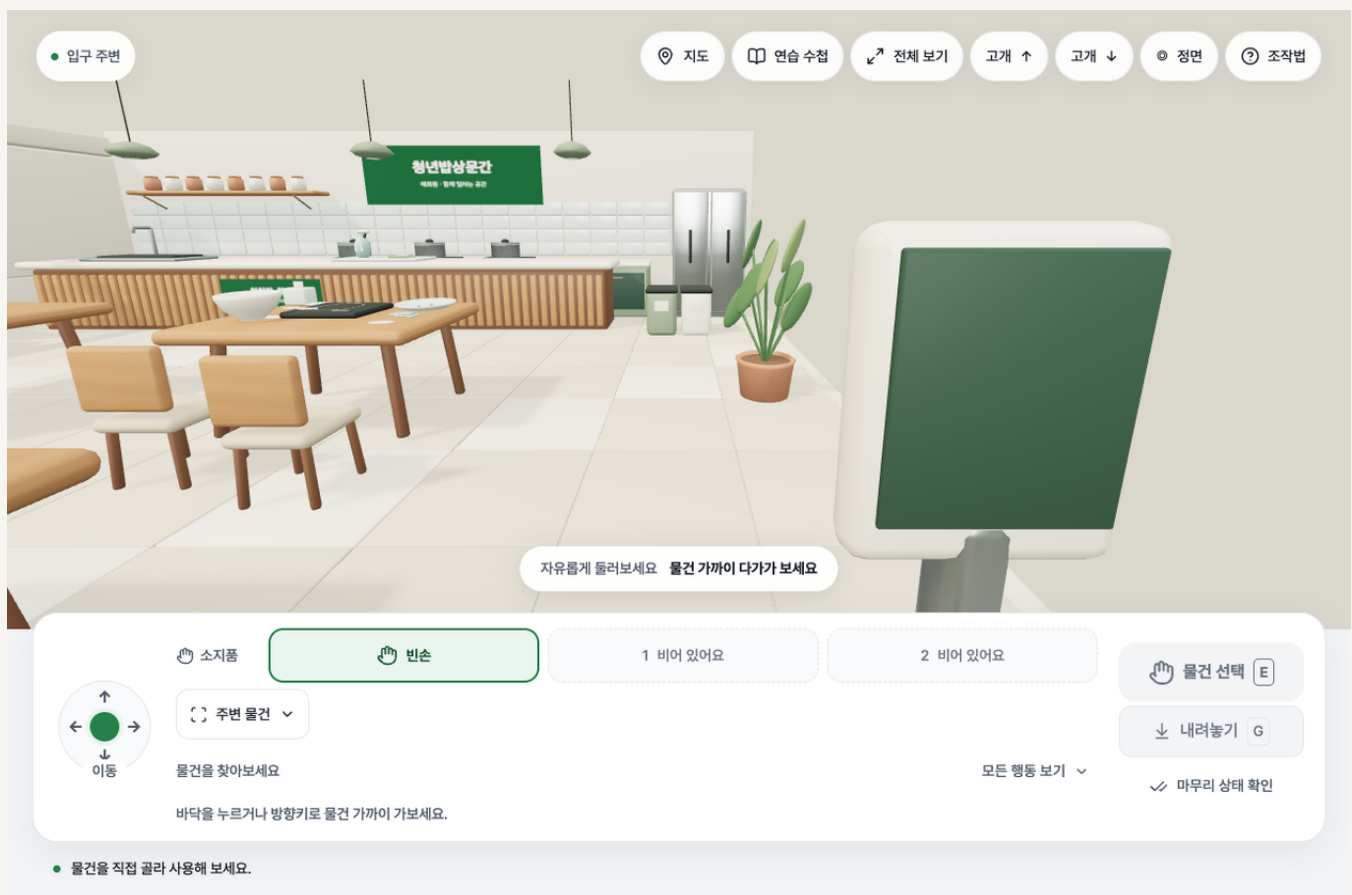
WHERE WE ARE TODAY

Review each step of a task, then practice setting a table in a virtual restaurant. We're exploring how workplace guides can go beyond instructions and become something people can practice with.



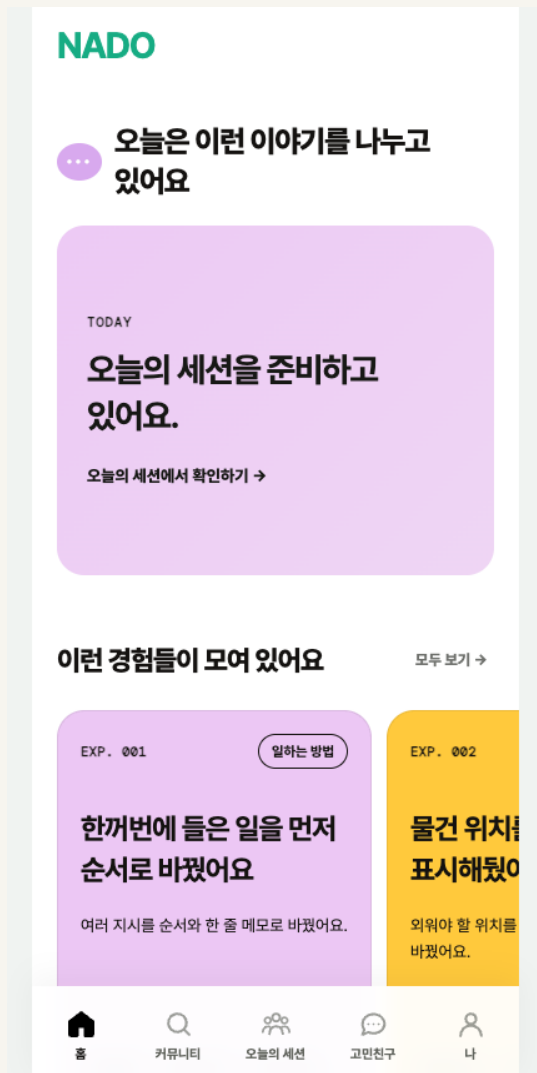
Workplace-practice prototype showing a virtual restaurant and step-by-step task guidance. Demo content shown.
